### The Programme and Subsidy Schemes

- Government Vaccination Programme (including Residential Care Home Vaccination Programme)
  - Seasonal influenza vaccine
  - Pneumococcal vaccine (if no previous vaccination)
- Elderly Vaccination Subsidy Scheme (EVSS)
  - Seasonal influenza vaccine
  - Pneumococcal vaccine (if no previous vaccination)
- Childhood Influenza Vaccination Subsidy Scheme (CIVSS)
  - Seasonal influenza vaccine





### **■**Aims

- Protect public health
- Reduce risk of severe disease and mortality arising from influenza infection and its complications in high risk people
- Minimise chance of invasive pneumococcal disease in elderly people





# Government Vaccination Programme (GVP)



### Government Vaccination Programme (中間生物後中心

- Free seasonal influenza vaccination for the following target groups:
  - Pregnant women receiving CSSA;
  - Elderly persons living in residential care homes;
  - Long-stay residents of institutions for the disabled;
  - Persons aged 50 years or above receiving
     Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA);
  - Elderly persons aged 65 years or above with chronic medical problems and followed up in public clinics;
  - Persons under 65 years with chronic medical problems who are on CSSA, and some long-stay HA in-patients who had chronic medical problems.

## Government Vaccination Programme @ \*\*\*



- Free seasonal influenza vaccination for the following target groups:
  - Children between the age of 6 months and less than 6 years from families receiving CSSA;
  - Health care workers of the DH, HA and other government departments, as well as health care workers in elderly homes or institutions for the disabled;
  - Poultry workers or staff who may be involved in poultry culling operations; and
  - Pig farmers and pig-slaughtering industry personnel





### **Government Vaccination Programme**

- One dose of free pneumococcal vaccine for elders aged 65 or above who have not received pneumococcal vaccination previously, and:
  - live in residential care homes for the elderly or disabled; or
  - have chronic medical problems and being followed up in public clinics; or
  - are receiving CSSA





### **Government Vaccination Programme**

- ■Place of vaccinations
  - HA clinics and hospitals
  - DH clinics
  - Residential care homes (under Residential Care Home Vaccination Programme)

### Residential Care Home Vaccination Programme

- Part of Government Vaccination Programme
- Eligibility
  - Seasonal influenza vaccination
    - ♦ All residents and staff in residential care homes
  - Pneumococcal vaccination
    - ♦ Residents aged 65 or above who have not received pneumococcal vaccination before



### **Residential Care Home Vaccination Programme**

- Vaccines provided by Government
- ■No vaccination charge for residents and staff
- Visiting Medical Officer (VMO) to provide vaccination service in residential care homes
- ■VMO claims a fee of \$50 per injection via eHealth System after service





# Elderly Vaccination Subsidy Scheme (EVSS)





### **EVSS – Eligibility**

- Hong Kong resident
- AND
  - 65 years old or above in the year of injection.e.

    Birth year = 1947 or earlier are eligible for subsidy in 2012



### **EVSS**



- Private medical doctors enrolled in the EVSS provide vaccination service
- Details of enrolled doctors are uploaded in CHP's website (www.chp.gov.hk)
- Government subsidy
  - Seasonal influenza vaccine
    - ◆ One dose : HK\$130
  - Pneumococcal vaccine
    - ◆ One dose : HK\$190(if no previous vaccination)

# Steps to take to receive vaccination under EVSS

- Step 1. Select a private medical doctor enrolled in the vaccination scheme
- Step 2. Bring along one's HK Identity card or Certificate of Exemption and vaccination card (if any)
- Step 3. Fill in and sign the Consent to Use Vaccination Subsidy form

# Childhood Influenza Vaccination Subsidy Scheme (CIVSS)

### **CIVSS - Eligibility**

- ■HK resident
- **AND** 
  - Either aged 6 months to < 6 years old</li>
    - ♦ (on the day receiving 1<sup>st</sup> dose of flu vaccine)

OR

- Age ≥ 6 years attending pre-primary institution
  - (proof by student handbook/student card/certificate by institution)



### HP 衛生防護中心 Centre for Health Protection

### CIVSS

- Private medical doctors enrolled in the CIVSS provide seasonal influenza vaccination service
- Details of enrolled doctors are uploaded in CHP's website (www.chp.gov.hk)
- Level of government subsidy
  - ♦ Seasonal influenza vaccine: one dose HK\$130
  - ◆ Up to 2 doses

### Steps to take to receive vaccination under CIVSS

- **Step 1** Select a private medical doctor enrolled in the vaccination scheme
- **Step 2** Bring along the necessary documents:
  - 1) Child's HK Birth Certificate / HK Identity Card
  - 2) If the child is aged 6 years or above and studies in pre-primary institution in HK
    - Child's Student Handbook / Student Card / Pick up Card and submit a photocopy to the doctor;
    - or; Submit a stamped Pre-primary Institution Certificate Form
  - 3) A completed Consent to Use Vaccination Subsidy signed by parent/guardian
  - 4) Child's immunisation record / vaccination card
